## Course Objectives:

- Develop skills necessary to perform alone or in a group;
- Learn appropriate etiquette both as a performer and listener;
- Perform to the best of their ability;
- Develop music-reading and sight-reading abilities;
- Achieve a high level of performance through the development of tone quality, intonation, style, technique, balance, and blend appropriate to an intermediate/advanced ensemble;
- Increase musical understanding through the study of composers, music history, and the music of other cultures.


## Class Expectations:

## Grading Policy:
